SHOA: We have had a number of inquiries from homeowners as to when their streets may be closed to traffic, due to our upcoming paving project. As you know, our project will start on Monday, May 22nd. On Thursday, May 18th, members of our Board will meet with the contractor to lay out a schematic of our streets to be paved, including an expected timetable by street. Even though the project starts on May 22nd, our streets will not start to be closed off until at least a week later. We will notify you as quickly as possible of the anticipated timing of actual paving, so you can notify your vendors. Once paving begins, selected streets will be closed to traffic for at least 24 hours, except around the cul-desacs, which will be closed for 48 hours. The cul-de-sac closing will impact mainly large trucks (garbage trucks) that need the cul-desac to turn around. We appreciate your full cooperation while this project is being undertaken.
