

Dear Strand, Single-Family Homeowners:

We would like to provide an update regarding current and future irrigation water usage within The Strand.

At this time, irrigation water is a limited resource and should be considered a privilege. To help ensure that available water is distributed as fairly and efficiently as possible throughout the community, we ask that homeowners **do not manipulate, adjust, or reprogram their irrigation clocks or watering schedules**. Irrigation settings are being managed centrally based on the available water supply and community-wide needs.

Please understand that the current irrigation schedules are designed primarily to support established turf areas and mature landscaping. Homeowners who have seasonal flowers, newly installed landscaping, or other plant material that requires more frequent watering may need to provide supplemental watering using a garden hose or conventional sprinkler system.

Unfortunately, some seasonal flowers and more temperamental plantings may not receive sufficient irrigation under the current restrictions. Homeowners who are away from the community for extended periods and have such plant material should be aware that these plants may not survive without additional hand watering.

We also want to make it clear that management and community leadership is directing these irrigation policies and restrictions. These decisions are not being made by Leo Jr., who is simply conducting the directives and guidelines that have been established.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation, understanding, and patience as we work through these water management challenges and strive to maintain the overall health and appearance of our community landscaping.
